

Language Teaching Methodology Courses

These are highly practical training programme which covers a broad span of teaching ideas and activities to enliven lessons and make them more motivating. These courses are for Language Teachers who need to take a look at ideas to refresh their methods and techniques. Participants need to be at a B1 level of English.

Teaching Skills and Language—This is a course for teachers of languages. On this course, one will consider the four language skills: speaking, writing, reading and listening and the language systems of grammar and vocabulary. The course will address the problems learners might have with learning about or using the skills and systems; and how one can help our learners with these problems and teach more effectively. Participants should have a minimum English language level corresponding to B1 on the CFR.
