The course will address the problems learners might have with learning about or using the skills and systems; and how you can help your learners with these problems and teach more effectively. Participants should have a minimum English language level corresponding to B1 on the CFR.

CLIL -Content and Language Integrated Learning -This course explores the history of teaching content in English and English through content, and identifies the principles underlying effective practice. You will look at the necessary skills required for CLIL teachers, explore materials and methodologies appropriate to CLIL and raise language awareness and linguistic competences. Key issues in course design will be examined, as well as testing and assessment procedures in CLIL contexts. Participants should have a minimum English language level corresponding to A2+on the CFR.
