### Target Audience

These courses are for Teachers working in Primary Education who need to refresh their methods and techniques. The course uses practical hands-on techniques which address and motivate the primary learners. Participants need to be at a B1 level of English.

#### **Course Overview and Outcomes**

As a participant on this course you will explore the principles and practice of teaching English to young learners. You will also extend your personal, professional and classroom language. This is a highly practical course which encourages you to explore active pedagogies as well as collaborative and creative strategies to enhance your teaching. By experiencing the power of storytelling & story-reading, playing educational games, exploring arts and crafts activities and the world outside the classroom, you will build a collection of diverse teaching tools, materials and techniques. You will consider cross-curricular activities, and approaches to content teaching through English with younger learners. You will also have the chance to try out some of the activities through dedicated micro-teaching sessions with your course colleagues.

#### Content

Teaching Young Learners includes content drawn from some or all of the following areas:

- Personal language awareness;
- Classroom language;
- Active pedagogical approaches and classroom management
- Listening activities for YLs
- Games and other activities in the YL classroom
- Learning through stories: Storytelling / story-reading activities
- Evaluating and adapting materials for teaching English to young learners
- Songs, arts & crafts, and drama in the YL classroom
- Exploring the world outside the classroom
- CLIL and cross-curricular activities with Young Learners
- Activity sharing and micro-teaching

Specific course content comes from feedback you and other participants give us through pre-course questionnaires, identifying your needs and priorities. We build time into the course for reflection, to consider how to adapt the content to your own professional context.
