English & Culture for 50Plus

The 50Plus programme is offered eight times per year and is offered for more mature learners who wish to combine learning English with their interest in learning about culture. It focuses very much on fluency and developing the confidence you need to speak English for everyday situations and conversations.

When booked on this course, you follow guided excursions to places of deep historic cultural interest, as well as participate in social and leisure activities of your choice. The course will give you the opportunity to get to know the rich culture of York and England with a focus on history, art, architecture, literature and cuisine.

As a 50Plus learner, you take 20 lessons per week of 45 minutes each. Lessons are held every morning, and are followed by specially organised excursions and activities where you can encounter culture and practise your English at the same time.

Intensive York Course (IYC)



A level of A2 is required to join either the IELTS Academic Stream or the English for Work Stream. Streams are run with a minimum of 6 students per stream. All new IYC students need to spend at least 6 weeks in the IYC Fluency stream.

LANGUAGE STREAM

You concentrate on improving your 4 core language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) and improving all areas of language knowledge (vocabulary, grammar and pronunciation) around a wide variety of topics.

SPECIALIST STREAM

You can choose to concentrate on your preferred learning pathway depending on why you need to improve your English.

1. IYC FLUENCY STREAM

By following the Fluency Stream, you develop fluency and become a confident speaker of English as you engage in oral communication activities based on recent and interesting topics in multinational classes.

2. IYC IELTS ACADEMIC STREAM

If you want to study for the IELTS exam, and develop the skills you will need to be successful when studying at an international university, then this stream is ideal for you.

3. IYC ENGLISH FOR WORK STREAM

If you want to improve your English for Work, then this stream lets you build your business vocabulary, and improve your skills for the workplace e.g. participating in meetings, negotiating, meeting and influencing customers, etc.

Professional English Courses

Business English Communication

Become more effective when communicating with international contacts. By following a Business Communication group course, you will develop the English you need at work: grammar and business / profession-specific vocabulary. You can also work on your professional communication skills such as leading / participating in (virtual) meetings, delivering presentations, negotiating, telephoning, socialising and writing emails. This course will also help you increase your intercultural competence (understanding 'culture', profiling your own and others' culture) and give you tips to manage diversity effectively. Individual training is available if desired to create a combination course of individual and group training.
