

Teaching Skills and Language—This is a course for teachers of languages. On this course, you will consider the four language skills: speaking, writing, reading and listening and the language systems of grammar and vocabulary. The course will address the problems learners might have with learning about or using the skills and systems; and how you can help your learners with these problems and teach more effectively. Participants should have a minimum English language level corresponding to B1 on the CFR.

Video, Image and Story in language Education —This course is for language teachers who wish to incorporate story, video and image in their teaching. The course addresses how video can engage language learners' needs for narrative. Participants should have a minimum English language level corresponding to B1 on the CFR.

Technology Assisted Learning -This course is for teachers interested in developing their skills in any aspect of applications of Information and Communication Technology. Participants should have a minimum English language level corresponding to B1+ on the CFR.

Teaching Young Learners These courses are for Teachers working in Primary Education who need to refresh their methods and techniques. The course uses practical hands-on techniques which address and motivate the primary learners. Participants need to be at a B1 level of English.

CLIL -Content and Language Integrated Learning -This course explores the history of teaching content in English and English through content, and identifies the principles underlying effective practice. Key issues in course design will be examined, as well as testing and assessment procedures in CLIL contexts. Participants should have a minimum English language level corresponding to A2+on the CFR.
